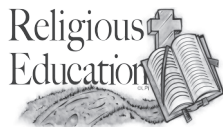

Retrouvaille: Help for hurting marriages: Retrouvaille (pronounced retro-vi with a long i) is not a spiritual retreat, sensitivity group, seminar, or social gathering. Retrouvaille is a worldwide program that teaches couples how to rediscover each other and work through difficult times in their marriages. This program offers an opportunity for you and your spouse to work privately on your marriage.

During the weekend phase of Retrouvaille, a series of presentations are given by a team of three couples and a priest. The team presents a technique of communication that enables you to take a good look at most areas of your relationship. After each presentation you have time in the privacy of your room to dialog about concepts from the presentation.

Hey Moms! Life is hectic and stressful sometimes-take a refreshing break at the **Retreat for Busy Catholic Moms**. The Sisters of Providence are hosting a weekend of sharing, prayer, reflection and laughter, to leave you rejuvenated and ready to face the challenges in your life. It will be held at Saint-Mary-of-the-Woods in Terre Haute, from 7:00 p.m. on Friday, February 17, until 1:30 p.m. on Sunday, February 19. Cost is \$225 for boarders, and \$125 for commuters.

The parish will be offering a new study beginning in Lent: **The Mass Readings Explained**, by Dr. Brant Pitre. In 20-30 minutes, the Bible readings to be used in the Mass that Sunday will be explained by the historical, cultural, and theological context used by the writers of the Holy Scriptures. Each week is an independent session, no weekly commitment is required to attend any/all sessions. A Wednesday morning session at 10:00 and a Wednesday evening session at 7:30 will be offered. 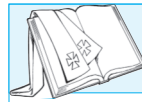
