To begin, a big thank you to everyone who made our visiting missionary priest feel at home at St. Mary's this weekend! Every priest who visits here comments on the how friendly and welcoming folks are. I know he appreciated your kindness very much! I am sorry to have missed the K of C's chili cook off! I hope everyone had a great time!

It does not happen very often but this weekend's readings and prayers for the celebration of Mass are "replaced" by a major Feast. This Sunday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. It commemorates the presentation in the temple of the child Jesus by Mary and St. Joseph, thereby dedicating Him to God the Father. As the first born male, the parents were called to offer their boy child to the mission and life of God's service. Aged Simeon and Anna rejoiced to have lived long enough to see the longed for Messiah of Israel. His beautiful "now, Lord, You can let Your servant go in peace," is prayed daily in the Breviary, or Liturgy of the Hours. The day is also referred to as "Candlemas Day." It comes from the custom of having candles blessed and used in the home for prayer, protection from storms and, most importantly, when Holy Communion is brought to the sick and homebound. To be honest, sadly this is no longer observed by many Catholic households. Don't ask me why: for I do not know. Back in the sixties, we got away from much of the beauty and devotions many of us grew up with. If you ever want candles blessed, white ones, just ask!

Stay warm, pray much and attend Mass! It will warm the cockles of your heart! God Bless You All!
