

In today's Gospel there's no denying Our Lord's words and command: "Do to others as you would have them do to you." Can't get much more clear than that, right?

Yet, too often we don't pray for our enemies, we neglect the needy, we hesitate to show another forgiveness and mercy ... even if they don't respect us. The Fish Frys will be each Friday of Lent with the exception of Good Friday, April 15th.
