

The bids have been submitted to the Archdiocese and we await their decision on how best to proceed. Needless to say, the cost will not come cheaply. The roof and parapets have been weakening from almost constant leakage for thirty years. Funding for the needed project will come from our Gold Envelope Fund as well as a loan from the Archdiocese. The amount of the loan is the decision we await. No one likes to borrow money; nor have a debt. In our case however, it will be a necessity. The building simply must be repaired or deteriorate further. We are a resilient parish, and we will do this together!
