He encourages us to use this freedom to love God and neighbor as we love ourselves. The Gospel reminds us that our focus needs to always be on the Lord Jesus, Who invites us to follow Him unreservedly.

I wish to bring everyone up to date regarding the repair of our church. We have received three bids for the replacement of the roof and the needed structural repairs to both the outer as well as inner walls. The bids have been submitted to the Archdiocese and we await their decision on how best to proceed. Needless to say, the cost will not come cheaply. The roof and parapets have been weakening from almost constant leakage for thirty years. Funding for the needed project will come from our Gold Envelope Fund as well as a loan from the Archdiocese. The amount of the loan is the decision we await. No one likes to borrow money; nor have a debt. In our case however, it will be a necessity. The building simply must be repaired or deteriorate further. We are a resilient parish, and we will do this together!

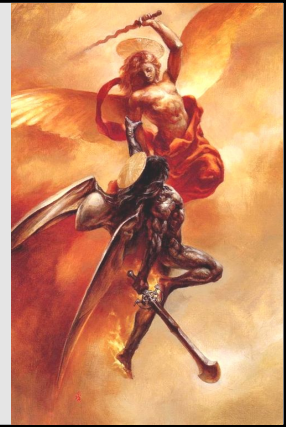
