

As we gather for Holy Mass this weekend, we remember this past Monday was the twenty-second anniversary of the horrible and diabolical attacks of September 11, 2001. Today's scriptures are timely and incredibly challenging for us because they speak about forgiveness.

Sirach tells us "to forgive your neighbor's injustice." Our Lord tells St. Peter that he must forgive not seven times, but seventy-seven times. Forgiveness in the face of incalculable tragedy, hate and enormous brutality can be unthinkable for many, even for devoted Christians and those who survive such attacks.

Yet, here we are with these words of Our Lord Jesus, calling us to forgive. There simply is no easy answer as we remember that day.
