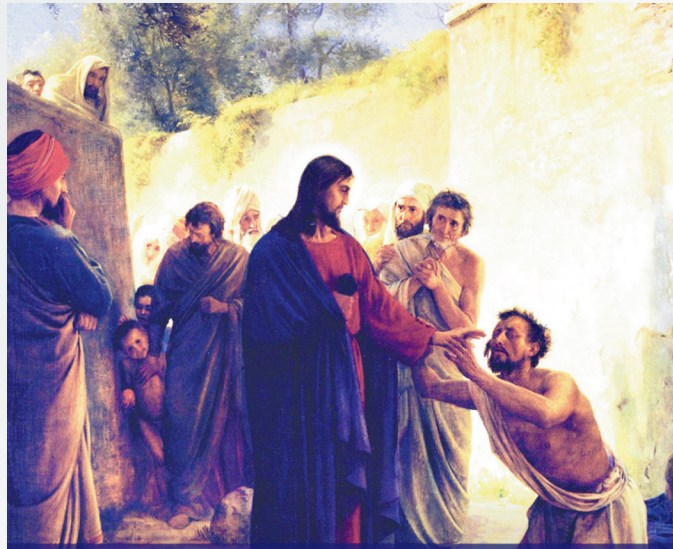

Holy Thursday Foot-Washing Rite in the Catholic Church

The foot-washing rite on Holy Thursday, also called the Mandatum ("command"), is a symbolic act in the Catholic Mass of the Lord's Supper that imitates Jesus' final act of service before His Passion. In the Gospel of John, Jesus washes the feet of His disciples at the Last Supper, saying, "You should wash one another's feet... I have set an example that you should do as I have done for you" (John 13:1-17)

Purpose and Meaning

The rite is a pastoral and spiritual gesture emphasizing humility, selfless service, and the call to love one's neighbor as oneself. It reminds the faithful that no one is above serving others, and that true greatness comes from service
